

RECIPROCAL FLIGHT ATTENDANT JUMPSEAT AGREEMENT

Air Wisconsin Airlines Corporation and Spirit Airlines agree to a reciprocal interchange of cabin jumpseat privileges for current qualified Flight Attendants of the two companies. This agreement is subject to the following restrictions:

- Jumpseat transportation is contingent upon availability and/or load restrictions.
- Jumpseat transportation is limited to commuting to/from an assigned base or for pleasure travel and will not be used for the purpose of conducting company business.
- Passenger cabin seating will be provided, and flight attendants will be allowed to occupy an open seat in the cabin only after all other revenue and non-revenue standby passengers have been assigned seats. Access to the Flight Deck will be strictly prohibited.
- User agrees to leave the aircraft on any stop when requested to do so by a company representative.
- There is no limit to the number of OA (other airline) flight attendants that may occupy an open cabin seat.
- If traveling to an international destination, user will carry passport, VISA or any other documents necessary to satisfy customs, immigration, public health or security at each point of entry.
- User agrees to be responsible for paying any and all international departure taxes and fees.

Procedures for Flight Attendant Jumpseat Travel on Air Wisconsin Airlines Corporation.

- Must be in uniform or business casual attire.
- Must be considered active working status. May not be a trainee, furloughed or on a leave of absence.
- Complete a Jumpseat Authorization form at least one hour prior to departure time. Forms should be available at all check-in locations.
- Provide a current company photo identification badge.
- Boarding will begin with the first jumpseat rider to have checked in, with priority given to Air Wisconsin Airlines personnel.
- Company identification must be displayed on the outer most garment above the waist at all times.
- There is no compensation or re-accommodation provided in the case of lost luggage, failure to be boarded or if you are bumped en-route.
- Strict professional conduct and decorum will be observed at all times.

Jumpseat travel is a discretionary courtesy and is subject to all applicable F.A.R.'s, company regulations and permission from the Captain. Air Wisconsin Airlines reserves the right to change, alter or cancel any condition of the agreement at any time.

RECIPROCAL FLIGHT ATTENDANT JUMPSEAT AGREEMENT


Spirit Airlines and Air Wisconsin Airlines agree to a reciprocal interchange of cabin jumpseat privileges for current qualified Flight Attendants of the two companies. This agreement is subject to the following restrictions:

- Jumpseat transportation is contingent upon availability and/or load restrictions.
- Jumpseat transportation is limited to commuting to/from an assigned base or for pleasure travel and will not be used for the purpose of conducting company business.
- User agrees to leave the aircraft on any stop when requested to do so by a company representative.
- If traveling to an international destination, user will carry passport, VISA or any other documents necessary to satisfy customs, immigration, public health or security at each point of entry.
- User agrees to be responsible for paying any and all international departure taxes and fees.
- User declares that they are not prohibited by any law or government regulation from receiving free jumpseat transportation.
- User must be in business attire or full uniform.
- User must be on active working Flight Attendant status, and may not be a trainee, be furloughed or be a contract employee.
- User must ACM (Additional Crew Member) pass one (1) hour prior to scheduled departure. These must be obtained at the ticket counter. Signed copies will be given to the Gate Agent and to the Captain prior to boarding.
- User must provide a present company photo identification card.
- User agrees to assume all risk related to accident or injury, including personal injury or death, or loss or damage to property, and agrees that Spirit Airlines, Inc. will not be held liable for any such injury, death, loss or damage whether caused by Spirit Airlines, Inc. or its agents.
- Users will be boarded, beginning with the first jumpseat rider to have checked in, with priority being given to Spirit Airlines personnel.
- Luggage is not to be checked in at the ticket counter, as boarding is not assured. If luggage does not fit in available carry on space, luggage may be checked at the gate.
- Users will observe strict professional conduct and decorum at all times.

Jumpseat travel is a "discretionary courtesy," and is subject to all applicable F.A.R.s, Company regulations and permission from the Captain. Spirit Airlines reserves the right to change, alter or cancel any condition of the agreement at any time. Each person using this privilege must observe strict professional conduct and decorum, and wear appropriate dress for interline travel or full uniform.


